## Please Note!

### There are changes to reporting and earning Book Bucks and prizes!

1. Registration for the Summer Reading Program is online!
2. Earn Book Bucks for **minutes** read, not **pages** read.
3. Check out and read books, magazines or other library materials.
4. When you are ready to log your books, **SIGN ON TO** the Summer Reading Website to enter and log the books and time spent reading.
5. Prizes are **ONLY** given when you visit the library. Come in to and collect a coupon to be re-deemed for prizes. The website will calculate how many minutes, **NOT PAGES**, were read.
6. A coupon will be issued to redeem prizes in our store, **The Stage Door**
7. Book Bucks are earned using the following scale:

#### Book Buck Earning Scale

Minimum minutes read per day to earn one (1) Book Buck
